## Kids mode


A mode where users can learn about disaster prevention through games using mostly hiragana characters.



This sheet is designed to help each person prepare for wind and flood damage and organize appropriate disaster prevention actions in advance to prevent panic during an emergency.



**Use in the event of a disaster**

**Confirmation of disaster information**

You can check 'evacuation information', 'weather information', 'earthquake information' and 'national protection information' for the area you have registered and the Tokyo metropolitan area.

**Disaster prevention map**

You can easily find the location of various disaster prevention facilities on a map, and switch between the 'Flood Risk Map', 'Area Risk Map' and other maps on a single screen. If you download the maps in advance, you can view them even when you are offline.



**Group contact**

Create and register groups of family members and friends within the app to send and receive text messages, including location information, in the event of a disaster.
