


Are you taking steps to prepare your bathroom for disasters?

The "portable toilet stockpile rate" for households in Tokyo is about ● %

22.9% of households in Tokyo have a stockpile of portable toilet more than 3 days', while 16.2 % have less than 3 days' worth.

On average, the bathroom is used five times per day

The Tokyo Toilet Disaster Prevention Master Plan assumes bathroom usage of 5 times per day. In fact, it may be more difficult to refrain from using the bathroom than to go without food or drink. During past disasters, some people have chosen to refrain from eating or drinking to avoid needing to use the bathroom. Avoid using the bathroom to prevent health issues like economy class syndrome or fatalities related to disasters.

Toilet Disaster Preparedness Q&A

Q: Where can I buy emergency toilet supplies?

You can purchase it at home improvement stores and on online shopping sites.

Q: How do I use it?

Attach the bag to the Western-style toilet bowl (by placing it over it) for use.

Q: Where can I use it?

If the water cannot be flushed, you can still use a Western-style toilet bag. Attach the bag to the toilet and use it at home or elsewhere.

If Western-style toilets or similar fixtures are damaged, they can also be attached to and used with portable toilets.

Q: What should I choose?

For example, please refer to whether the following specifications are met:

- ① The usage method is easy to understand, such as through illustrated instructions.
- ② It has a mechanism and size that allows it to be attached and secured to fixtures like toilets.
- ③ It possesses sufficient absorption and solidification capacity.
- ④ Measures are in place to suppress odors.



Q: What should I do after buying it?

To avoid panic during a disaster, try using your purchased items at least once beforehand to check for usability issues. Also, keep compact, easy-to-carry products with you to be prepared for emergencies.

Q: What should I do after using it?

Solidified human waste treated with coagulants can be disposed of as combustible waste.
