Rescue training 11:00 - 11:45

At the soccer field within Hirai Sports Park, we will have a rescue drill simulating a flooding caused by heavy rain from typhoon. In the drill, we will be conducting information gathering using drones, draining water by drainage pump vehicle, and jointly handled rescue operations by police, fire department, self-defence forces, etc. Also, check out the activities on the Arakawa River.



Exhibition and Hands-On Training 10:00-13:00

In addition to meticulously-planned exhibitions and performances pertaining to disaster reduction planned by disaster response entities, these organizations will also display special-purpose vehicles. Additionally, there will be performances by the Tokyo Fire Department Music Band and the Japan Ground Self-Defence Force 1st Division Band.
